### Purpose & Participation

The YMCA Y-Adventure Guides and Trailblazers programs are designed to bring a child and his/her father together to enjoy mutually rewarding activities. It allows the dad and child to focus on each other... to express their love and share it... to foster companionships between one another and new friends... to share responsibility and leadership opportunities... and to build self esteem and personal worth.

Any dad and son and/or daughter may participate in the Y-Adventure Guides (grades K-3) or Trailblazers (4-6 grade). If there is not a parent able to participate in the program, any adult may serve as the child's sponsor.

### Program Structure & Activities

A circle, the basic unit of the program, consists of six to ten dad-child pairs. Circles are assigned and organized by neighborhoods, ages of children, schools, available meeting dates, and/or circle availability. Circle meetings are held once a month, usually on weekday evenings, and rotated among members' homes. Meeting activities include games, songs, stories, crafts, snacks, ceremonies, goal setting, the planning of field trips and events that occur once a month.

Circles join together with other circles in the same geographical location to form an Expedition. The Expedition facilitates the exchange of ideas, unity and monthly events such as parades, campouts, bowling, biking, and much more!

With the help of the children in the program, Trailblazers will also be planning campouts, outdoor adventures and service projects in our local community. The activities that will be planned will encourage building skills, values, healthy habits and of course... fun! The Trailblazers program supports the vital role parents play as teachers, counselors and friends.
